

AirPlus & SEB Kort Merger Checklist for Cardholders

The legal merger between AirPlus International GmbH and SEB Kort Bank AB is planned to be completed by **3 August 2026**.

Here's a quick summary of the most important things to know about the legal merger:

- Your agreement stays valid with no changes.
- Your AirPlus Corporate Card, its card number, expiration date, and PIN will not change.
- AirPlus will remain as a product brand for your corporate card under SEB Kort.

However, the legal merger will result in some **changes that are relevant for you and will require action from your side**. For this purpose, we have prepared this checklist to **complete on August 3, 2026**.

Details	What is changing?	Actions to take
Legal company name	Our legal company name will change from AirPlus International GmbH to SEB Kort Bank AB .	Please update our company name where relevant.
Invoices & payments	The issuer of your corporate card will be SEB Kort Germany, Branch of SEB Kort Bank AB. You will receive invoices from the new German branch, and your bank account statements will reflect our new name.	When settling your invoices, please address payments to the new German branch, SEB Kort Germany, Branch of SEB Kort Bank AB.
SEPA direct debit mandates	While existing SEPA direct debit mandates will remain valid after the merger, the change of the beneficiary may still be relevant for your bank.	If you have an existing SEPA direct debit mandate, we recommend that you inform your bank about the new beneficiary.
